The son of former Frankston Indians athlete Keith Ellis has committed to play football at Louisiana Tech University, his father has reported.

He is Austin Ellis, currently a junior at Bullard High School, where he plays football. Ellis is a 6'5", 290-pound offensive tackle who is rated a 3-Star Prospect by 247 Sports and Rivals. He was a first team 8-4A All-District Offensive Lineman and first team All Rose Country Offensive Tackle.

The athlete also has offers from UNLV (Las Vegas), Texas A&M Commerce and Midwestern State.

His older brother, Peyton, is currently an Offensive Tackle at Texas A&M Commerce. His sister, Shanna, is a senior at Bullard High School.

Austin is the grandson of the late Ralph and Paula Ellis and the great grandson of the late Mr. and Mrs. Clyde Ellis, all of Frankston, whose family formerly owned and operated the legendary Ellis Mercantile store, located on the corner of West Main and SH 155 in downtown Frankston.

His parents are Keith, coach and teacher at Bullard, and Suzan Ellis. His uncles are Kevin Ellis and Mike Ellis, also notable Frankston athletes, and his aunt is Leslie Ellis Green, also a FHS graduate, who was notable in extra-curricular activities.
