

8th Grade Maidens top Cross Roads 50-2; 7th grade teams knotted in tie

The Frankston 8th Grade Maidens defeated Cross Roads on the road 50-2 and the 7th grade Maidens, after a double overtime, ended in a 14-14 tie with their Cross Roads opponents on Monday, Dec. 6, according to a report from Coach Myka Daniels.

The eighth graders scored 16 points in the first quarter, 11 in the second, 8 in the third and 15 in the fourth quarter,
